Clubs Programme - Spring Term 2024

At Barrow we place great importance on the personal development of all children in our school. We believe in providing for learners' broader development and character education by enabling them to grow and discover their interests and talents, as well as develop resilience, confidence and independence. One of the ways we do this is by offering and signposting our pupils to a range of extra-curricular clubs and activities.

We are delighted to be in a position to be able to offer a full and wide-ranging selection of clubs over the Spring term. In addition to Mr Daniel's sports clubs and we are continuing to enjoy working with TF Music to provide individual and group music sessions.

School staff will also once again be offering a range of clubs, so we very much hope that there will be something for everyone; we have taken into account recent feedback from both parents and children when pulling together this term's offer. We hope that our varied selection, with a number of new clubs featuring alongside those that have already proved to be very popular, will encourage as many children as possible to sign up.

We will be sharing information about our club's programme in assembly and would ask that you now help your child to make their choices from the details below. The forms to register will be available on ParentMail and can be completed up until Midday on Wednesday,17th January 2024. We will then confirm which club your child has been allocated the following week.

Please note that the clubs do have limited spaces, but we will aim to accommodate as many children as possible. In order to avoid disappointment please express your child's interest/preference by selecting 3 different clubs.

Our after school clubs will commence the week beginning Monday 29th January and run for three weeks this half term and then continue after half term for the first three weeks of Spring II. Some clubs require a contribution to cover costs/resources. These fees should be paid via ParentMail in advance of clubs starting. Those children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding will be funded for one school-led or sports session per term. For those children who attend Barrow Extra afterschool sessions, there will be no adjustment to the fees and they will need to be paid for as usual.
