Covid Testing Reminder

Anyone who does not have Covid symptoms can do regular rapid lateral flow tests to check for the virus. You can get test kits sent to your home or collect them from pharmacies locally.

You should self-isolate immediately if you show any symptoms of COVID-19 and book a PCR test as soon as possible, even if you are fully vaccinated. If you are notified by NHS Test and Trace of a positive COVID-19 test result, you must complete your full self-isolation period. Your self-isolation period includes the day your symptoms started (or the day your PCR test or assisted lateral flow test was taken if you do not have symptoms), and the next 10 full days.

From 16th August you do not need to self-isolate if you are notified you have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 and any of the following apply:

- you are fully vaccinated
- you are below the age of 18 years and 6 months

Home Learning
