Teaching About Consent

At a really basic level, consent means asking for and waiting to hear a 'yes'. Consent is seeking and giving permission. School-age children are never too young to learn this in ways that make sense to them. If one friend wants to borrow something from another friend, they must get permission. If one friend wants to hug their friend, they should check if their friend is OK with that first. If a child doesn't want to play with another then that's OK.

Linking permission-seeking to physical contact is an important part of safeguarding children. They need to be taught about boundaries, saying no to unwanted touch and seeking help when they are worried or upset by anything they have been asked to do or by how they have been touched.

When adults are talking to children or dealing with these issues, either at home or in school, it's important to use the word 'consent' so that the children become more and more familiar with it's use, understand what it means and know how it works in context.

One Way System Changes Reminder

Following the new phase of government guidance 'Living with Covid-19', we have made some changes to our pick up and drop off arrangements.

- We no longer have a one way system in place on the school site.
- Families are free to use the main pedestrian entrance from Church Lane (past the UKS2 Teaching Block) **to both enter and exit the site.**
- The main gates onto Colethorpe Lane remain open **as a second EXIT point only to ease congestion.**
- Our slightly staggered start and finish times remain in place to ease congestion.
- Parents can continue to enter the site for both drop off and collection using the current access points.
