It has been a particularly active week in school as we followed on from Sports Day with another visit from the fabulous scooter training company, Scout Fit.

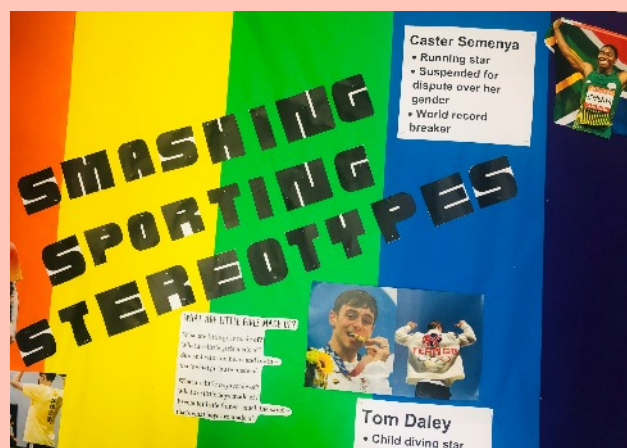
