The most expensive chocolate egg sold for £7,000!

The expensive egg sold in London in March 2012.

It was so expensive, it became the world record for the most expensive edible egg!

The egg was decorated with gold leaf and white flowers. It took three days to make!

The world's biggest Easter egg was more than 34 feet tall (taller than two stacked double decker buses!).

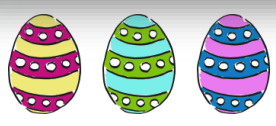
According to Guinness World Records, the chocolate egg weighed 15,873 pounds. It was made in Cortenuova, Italy.
