Dear parents/carers,

Year 6 Activity Week Monday 10th June – Friday 14th June 2024

It is already time to think about next summer! I am delighted to say that this year, we will be taking part in an action packed activity week.

Activity Week Timetable

Monday 10 th June 2024	Creative Day – this day will take place in school where the children will complete art and DT activities (including cooking).
Tuesday 11 th June 2024	Trip to Bury St Edmunds where the children will get a bus to the town centre. The children will then watch a film at the local Abbeygate Cinema and go on to have lunch and a round of bowling at Bury Bowl. The children will then get the bus back to school.
Wednesday 12 th - Friday 14 th June 2024	Residential to Eaton Vale Scout Centre where the children will take part in a range of activities and stay in the scout house for 2 nights.

At Eaton Vale we will be taking part in 10 activities. The activities will include abseiling, archery, climbing and kayaking, among other things. The group will be accommodated in a scout house onsite and full catering will be provided during the children's stay. For more information you can have a look at the website (www.eatonvale.co.uk) – what a fantastic opportunity!

The cost of the activity week will be **£220** and will include: coach travel to and from Eaton Vale; residential accommodation, activities and catering, and a trip to the cinema and bowling and lunch out in Bury St Edmunds, and cooking/art resources for the creative day.

This cost will be payable via Parent Mail. The cost of the activity week can be split into different payments, so that it can be paid for over a longer period of time.

I urge all parents to encourage your child to take part in this fantastic opportunity, especially attending the two night residential. Your child will only have one opportunity to take part in this Year 6 leavers trip and it will be a week that they will remember for many years to come. It is not a holiday week, but very much a part of their valuable school experiences. If you need some support with finding the money and think you may be entitled to some help, please come in and speak to a member of staff in confidence.

As an indication of intent from yourselves we ask you to pay via ParentMail a non-refundable deposit of £30 by Tuesday 31st October 2023. Please note that by paying the deposit a place will be allocated and you may be liable for the full cost in the event of a late withdrawal from the trip.

To make it as easy as possible for you we are happy for the remainder of the balance to be paid in instalments throughout the next few months, with the full balance to be paid by **Friday 26th April 2024**.
