Late Arrivals to School

Whilst we understand that there are those unavoidable occasions that can cause delays in getting to school on time, these should be rarities throughout the school year. Arriving late at school means that your child or children will have been rushed into class, they will have had an unsettled start to the school day out of their usual routine and will have missed out on a portion of their learning.

We have a very full timetable to ensure that the children are receiving a full and balanced curriculum. Your child needs to be in school every day by 8.50am so that they are ready to start their day of learning in a calm and settled manner. Parents need to be aware of any restrictions which may affect a timely arrival to school and adjust their departure to accommodate this.

We regularly look at late arrivals as part of our attendance monitoring. We also receive regular visits from our Local Authority Attendance Officer. The registration certificates of those children who frequently arrive late at school will be reviewed at our next visit. This could result in further action being taken.

If you are finding routines difficult to implement in the home we have an experienced Pastoral Team who are available to talk to you regarding hints and tips on how to maximise your time in the mornings as well as supporting ideas on motivating children into action.
