Remembrance Land Army Day

On Wednesday this week, Barrow School had the privilege of having the Women's Land Army Trust visiting the school. We enjoyed fascinating a assembly from Nicky, a land girl historian who helped us understand the different roles and responsibilities that were held from dairy work, to forestry, food production and heavy machinery. We



held a 2 minute silence to show our thanks and remembrance of those who gave their lives in war for the protection of others.



Teasel the Suffolk Punch horse also came, tacked up in his amazing leather and brass harnesses. The children spoke with his owners, who take him

across the country, teaching about the importance of horses in WW1 and WW2. The children were amazed at his size - 18 hands tall, weighing 1000kg!

In the afternoon we took part in many different activities, from butter churning to planting strawberries to writing



applications to join the Land Army. What a fantastic day experiencing living local history.
