## Home Learning 2024-2025

Following feedback from parents and reflecting our school priorities, we have made some changes to the frequency and the content of some of the tasks of home learning. Please look carefully below at the table to understand the expectation for your child's year group.

As parents, you can play an important role in your child's education by encouraging a healthy attitude to home learning right from the start of their school years.

All year groups, Year 1 to Year 6, **will be set their home learning on their Google Classroom class page. Please make sure you have accepted the invitation to your child's new year group class page.**

For **years 2-6**, each class teacher will set a home learning task on a **Friday** and it is expected that home learning is 'turned in' no later than the subsequent Friday, allowing 2 weeks for it to be completed. Year 1 have weekly phonic activities.

It is important that children submit evidence of their home learning when they 'turn in' their work, meaning they add an attachment or upload their work for example. Please ensure complete **all** pieces and upload them at the same time. Children will be awarded a merit if they complete and upload all tasks set.
