Parent Consultation Meetings – March 2026

We are very pleased to be able to offer you a Spring Term Parent Consultation Meeting with your child's class teacher in the coming weeks. These meetings will be held remotely via School Cloud video link.

Meetings for all classes from Reception to Year 5 will be held on the following evenings:

- Tuesday, 24th March from 3.30pm to 7pm
- Thursday, 26th March from 3.30pm to 5pm

Meetings for Year 6 will be held on the following evenings:

- Tuesday 14th April from 3.30pm to 7pm
- Thursday, 16th April from 3.30pm to 5pm

Through the consultation meeting offered, you will have the opportunity to catch up with your child's class teacher, discuss their progress so far this year and to raise any particular issues or questions you may have.

To conduct these meetings, we are once again using the online appointment booking system and secure video conferencing platform, School Cloud.

Appointments will be available to book from Friday, 6th March from 6pm.

If your child receives support through an Individual Education Plan (IEP), however, you will be contacted directly by the class teacher for a separate appointment. Please do not make an appointment via School Cloud.

Ahead of our Parent Consultation Meetings, we would like to offer you the opportunity to come into school and review your child's learning so far this year by inviting you to an open class event in each year group. Classes will be open from **2.45pm** on their allocated day when the children's books will be made available for you to look through and staff will be on hand for informal discussions.

As our space in classrooms is limited, can we politely request that no more than two adults per child attend these sessions and any pushchairs are left outside.

To further support your understanding of your child's progress and attainment so far this year, we will also be sharing end of term reports with parents. These overviews will once again offer you an overview of all subjects across the curriculum for the end of the Spring Term. We hope to share these one page summaries with you on Friday, 27th March.

We very much value an open and positive relationship between home and school and consider these meetings to be a vital aspect of working in partnership with our families. I would really encourage you to take this opportunity to contribute to and share in your child's experiences of school.
