## **CHILDREN'S SECTION**

Classes are open to boys and girls. In each class there are separate age groups divisions as shown, so arranged that Special Awards can be won by any child in the specified age groups. Children may only make entries in their own age group. The age groups, based on the child's age on the day of the show, are as follows:

- a) Under 5 years
- b) 5 to 8 years
- c) 9 to 12 years
- d) 13 – 15 years

Class Number

- 48 A miniature garden, using any plant, wood, stone on a tray not larger than 25 – 40 cm.
- 49 A hand decorated jam jar filled with garden flowers/foilage (Leaves)
- 50 A hand made greetings card

- 51 A window box Western scarecrow made with a wooden spoon and other materials
- 52 Using Lego create a model or sculpture, statue or ornament for the garden. The base should be no larger than 30cm x 30 cm
- 53 A plasticine or play dough or clay model or picture of a on a board (not larger than 7inch by 7 inch or 18 cm x 18 cm)
- 54 Write an original poem entitled The Cowboy (Age groups B,C,D,)
- 55 Make a model from a paper plate, tissue paper and cut out handprints (Age group A only)
- 56 Build a model robot from recyclable material
